Conditions

1. The holder of this certificate is authorised to engage in legal practice as, or in the manner of, a barrister only.
2. The holder of this certificate is not authorised to receive trust money other than in accordance with clause 15 of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Regulation 2015*.
3. The holder of this certificate may not supervise legal practise (as defined in s6 of the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW)) by others. [This condition does not preclude the holder acting as a tutor to a reader in accordance with the reading program].
4. The holder of this certificate is authorised to engage in legal practice as a volunteer at a community legal service, or otherwise on a pro bono basis, subject to compliance with the *Legal Profession Uniform Conduct (Barristers) Rules 2015*.
5. The holder of this certificate is not authorised to engage in legal practice as a volunteer at a community legal service, or otherwise on a pro bono basis.
6. The holder of this certificate may engage in legal practice as, or in the manner of, a barrister only as a government lawyer.
7. The holder of this certificate is not permitted to appear as a barrister without a leader in any court, tribunal or arbitration except with the permission of the Bar Council. For the purposes of this condition a leader is defined as a barrister who is senior counsel or who has more than seven years experience as a barrister and holds a current Australian practising certificate authorising legal practice as, or in the manner of, a barrister only.
